Semi-auto analyzer to provide 50 free examinations to rural people

Dhenkanal: A semi-auto analyzer machine was inaugurated by the District Collector and Magistrate Saroj Kumar Sethy at Health and Wellness Center of Sirimula under Kamakshyanagar subdivision for the benefit of entire rural population in the area. The wellness center is run by SOVA, a well-known social institution in the district.
